The Chamber maintains a comprehensive website, www.whitelake.org, where each member has a page with their contact information, address, and information pertaining to what the business does and provides. This is something Chamber staff puts together and maintains, however, each member also has access to make changes themselves if they wish.

- Access to add your own events to our community calendar, with a chance to be featured in our weekly eblasts, Here's What's Happening in the White Lake Area which go out every Monday to over 2,000 people.
- Participate in White Lake Area Gift Certificate Program. This program does not cost businesses anything, as each gift certificate is turned in and deposited like a regular check.
- Sponsorship opportunities. Each year the Chamber publishes a brochure of all sponsorship opportunities, and each current sponsor will always be given the first right of refusal to keep their sponsorship each year if they chose.
- Networking opportunities, such as Leads Group, networking events, potential after-hours networking events, etc.
- Ribbon cutting, grand opening, and celebration ceremonies:
 - WLACC creates invite for social media + eblast.
 - Gain exposure for your business before the event through our promotion of it, and after the event through pictures we take and share.
 - Invite the community to your business to learn more about what you do or your products.
 - Event invitation is added to our community calendar and sent out to all members in an eblast, as well as shared on our social media pages.
 - WLACC brings the big scissors and the ribbon

Frequently Asked Questions

- I don't have time to participate in things...is the WLACC for me? Yes! Your membership to the WLACC can take up as much or as little time as you want. As a member, you already receive automatic benefits that we provide that won't take up any of your time (see Chamber Member Benefits). In many of our sponsorship cases, you provide us the resources of a sponsorship and the WLACC takes care of the rest, meaning you won't have to put any time into it.
- My business is doing great and I don't need to network, so is the WLACC membership worth it?
 Given the mission and the vision of the WLACC, membership dues help the WLACC accomplish those things and help our area continue to connect community and create commerce. A business that is already successful and doesn't need to network or get their name out there can benefit by being a part of our growing commitment to the community and businesses, and also use it as a way to give back to the community that has helped them be successful.
- Are the Chamber and the government connected? I don't like to associate my business with politics.
 The Chamber of Commerce is not a government entity. The WLACC is a liaison to help speak for the business community to government officials at a local, state, and national level, as well as getting government policies and announcements out to the business community.
