- Send out an eblast to all members inviting them to your ribbon cutting.
- Invite the mayor, Chamber Board of Directors, and White Lake Beacon to be attendance.
- Facilitate the ribbon cutting. We will bring the ribbon, scissors, and if you are newly joining the Chamber of Commerce, we will bring your new Member plaque.

Ideas & Options

The ribbon cutting itself typically lasts 10-20 minutes. These ceremonies can be just the ribbon cutting, or your business may chose to turn it into an open house. Here are some ideas of what you may chose to do to get you started, however, none of these are required.

- Provide tours or walkthroughs of your business.
- Provide snacks and refreshments.
- Offer special in-store or service deals or discounts.
- Do drawings or giveaways for attendees.
- We encourage you to invite your friends, family, staff. business partners, and anyone you would like in attendance to help maximize the opportunity to get your business name out in the community.
